Purpose

The purpose of the Texas Delta Epsilon Chi Memorial Scholarship is to provide recognition and monies for National Career Development Conference registration fees to marketing and management education students for their academic excellence, leadership and involvement in Delta Epsilon Chi.

Qualifications

To receive the Texas Delta Epsilon Chi Memorial Scholarship a student must:

1. be a state and national Delta Epsilon Chi member
 2. have an overall cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or higher for the last two semesters (with 4.0 being equal to an A)
 3. participate in at least three areas listed under Delta Epsilon Chi activities, leadership and community/school activities
 4. be eligible to attend the National Career Development Conference
- **** Completed applications must be received by Texas Delta Epsilon Chi State Advisor or other designated Advisory Board member by the end of the opening session of the State Career Development conference.
- **** Recipients will be subject to final approval by their College Administration. Failure to comply with the community college system may result in disqualifying a recipient.
- **** Selection process: An independent judges(s) will process the applicants and determine the best qualified persons(s). The number of Memorial Scholarships will vary. It is possible that there may not be a recipient every year.
